The Port is located on the scenic North Coast of British Columbia. As Canada's second largest West Coast port and one of the largest ports in Canada, the Port is strategically situated on the Pacific Rim, with the deepest natural harbour in North America and direct rail and highway connections to the North American continent. PRPA administers lands home to a number of major marine-industrial facilities including modern, high-throughput coal and grain terminals, a cruise terminal, modern bio-fuels (wood pellet) export terminal, and one of the most efficient container terminals in North America, anchoring the fastest and most reliable intermodal trade corridor on the West Coast.

Due to dramatic and continuing growth at the Port, including plans for a number of significant new large scale terminal developments, PRPA is seeking a lawyer with a minimum of three to five years of experience to join its in-house legal team based in Prince Rupert, BC. Reporting to the Vice President, Commercial & Regulatory Affairs, this is a dynamic role covering commercial and corporate matters, marine and environmental law, regulatory affairs and aboriginal consultation and engagement.

The ideal candidate will have a broad range of commercial and corporate experience, with some previous exposure to real estate and project development matters, regulatory affairs and aboriginal law and consultation. In addition, experience in marine or rail transportation would be considered an asset. Candidates must be members, or be eligible for membership, of the Law Society of BC.
